

# CAUTION

## WOOD PLANER

### WEAR APPROPRIATE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

(eye, face, hearing, etc.)

- Never start the machine unless all the guards are in place and properly adjusted.
- Beware of all dangerous moving machinery parts.
- Keep the work area clean. Foreign materials may cause poor footing.
- Dust collection system, if provided, is connected and operational.
- Inspect workpiece for nails, screws, protruding knots, etc.
- Never stand directly behind work being processed.
- Check cutter-height adjustment before using.
- Do not work material too small for machine and personal safety.
- Do not attempt to remove an excessive amount of material at one time.
- De-energize and lockout all energy systems before making adjustments/repairs.
- Do not wear gloves, jewelry, or loose clothing.
- Ensure that operator is properly trained and has read the owner's operation manual.

Note: Immediately report all machinery malfunctions to management.
